Medical policy

Policy statement

It is important that a child is not brought into one of our event childcare settings if they are suffering from or showing symptoms of:

- Diarrhoea
- Vomiting
- Fever over 38°C,
- A new/undetermined rash
- Discharge from the eyes, ear and nose,
- Head lice
- If the child is feeling unwell

Parents will be notified if a child has been present who has an infectious disease. If a child becomes ill whilst in our care, the parents will be notified immediately, and the child should be collected as soon as possible to avoid distress and to prevent any infection from spreading.

Medication will only be administered in the creche only with written consent from the parents (see medication form). Only the key worker or the person in charge will administer this. Medication will only be accepted if it is in the original container and not out of date. If your child needs medication that requires technical/medical knowledge, this will be discussed.

Where the parents will be on-site at the venue, we request they return and administer the medication themselves.
